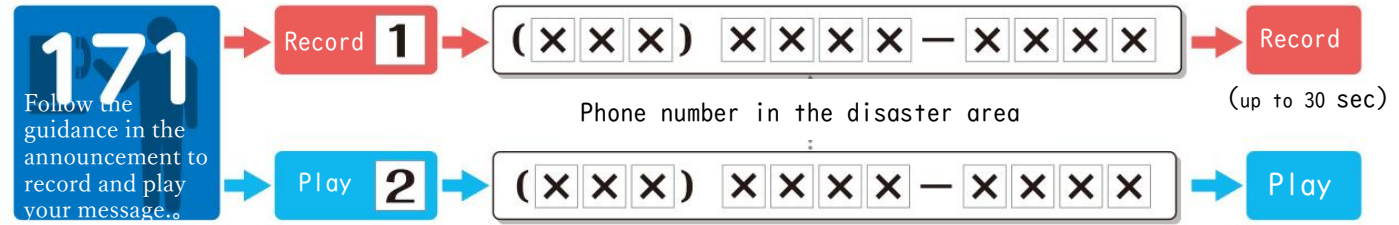

Disaster Emergency Message Number
171

This is an NTT voice messaging service that allows users to record and share their safety status when phone lines become overloaded due to a disaster such as earthquakes. Dial "171" and follow the audio guidance to record a message or play back messages.

We offer testing periods for this number to practice using it before a disaster.

- 1st and 25th of every month from: 0:00~24:00
- Disaster Preparedness Week (Aug 30, 9:00~Sep 5, 17:00)
- New Year (Jan 1, 0:00~Jan 3, 24:00)
- Prevention and Volunteer Week (Jan 15, 9:00~Jan 21, 17:00)
