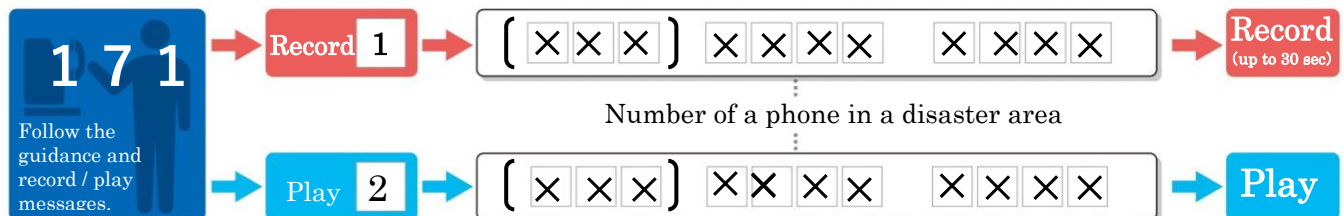
Disaster Emergency Message Service

Use this to contact your family or friends and to check on their safety.

Disaster Emergency
Message Number **171**

This is a voice messaging service through NTT which enables you to record and convey a message giving your status when phonelines are overloaded due to a disaster such as an earthquake. Dial "171" and follow the audio guidance. You can record a message or play messages to you.

- Prevention and Volunteer Week (19:00 Jan 15th- 17:00 Jan. 21st)
