

# Measures for wind and flood at home ②



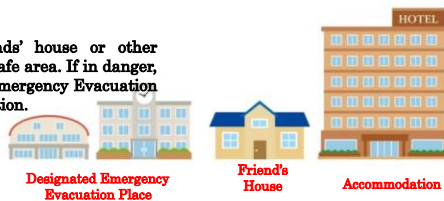
## Avoid “densely populated” evacuation sites. Disperse instead.

As alternatives to “Designated Emergency Evacuation Places,” consider places such as “relative’s/friend’s houses,” “hotel accommodations,” and “stay home evacuations.”

### Evacuation #1 Leaving

Relatives’/friends’ house or hotel accommodations

Evacuate to a friends’ house or other accommodation in a safe area. If in danger, go to a “Designated Emergency Evacuation Place” without hesitation.



### Evacuation #2 Securing at home

Stay home evacuation

If your house is not located in the “Assumed Flooding Area/Landslide (Special) Warning Area”, or not flooded even if it is located in the “Assumed Flooding Area” and you can evacuate to a floor higher than the 2nd floor, securing yourself at home is another option.

## Sediment disasters in Yamato City

There are 3 types of sediment disasters: “debris flow,” “landslides”, and “cliff collapse”. In Yamato City, “cliff collapses” are possible.

Evacuate quickly when you see the phenomena below:

### Cliff Collapse

Heavy rain and earthquakes can cause cliff collapse. This phenomenon happens quickly, putting people’s lives in danger if they fail to escape.



### Pay Attention to these signs:

- Water seeps from the cliff or suddenly gets muddy.
- Cracks appear in the cliff.
- Small stones begin falling from the cliff.
- Snapping sounds come from the roots. Trees and/or shrubbery lean or fall.

## Do you know the “2 warning areas” for sediment disasters?

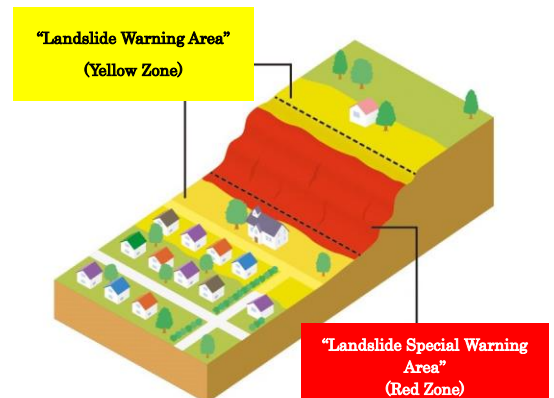
“Landslide Warning Areas” (Yellow Zone) and “Landslide Special Warning Areas” (Red Zone) are designated/announced by Kanagawa prefecture. Check your area and be prepared always for the possibility of sediment disaster.

### “Landslide Warning Area” (Yellow Zone)

In this area, there is danger of injury or death to residents due to possible landslide.  
Area prevention plans are determined, and a warning evacuation system is organized in order to announce disaster information or the need to evacuate quickly.

### “Landslide Special Warning Area” (Red Zone)

In this area, buildings can be easily damaged by landslide and residents’ lives are in danger.  
Developments are limited, structures are controlled, and relocation is recommended.
